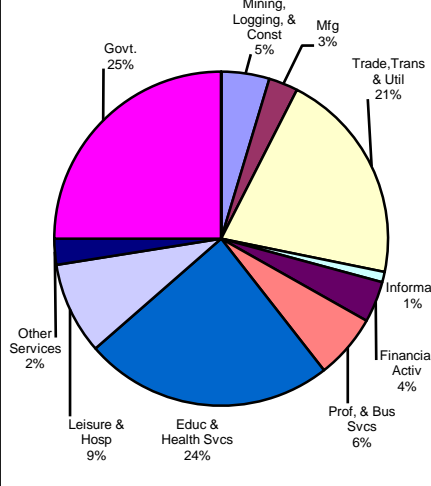
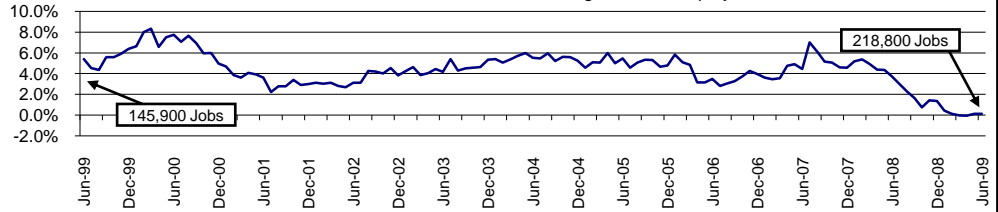


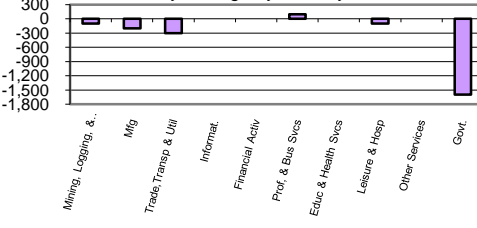
**Industry Composition**



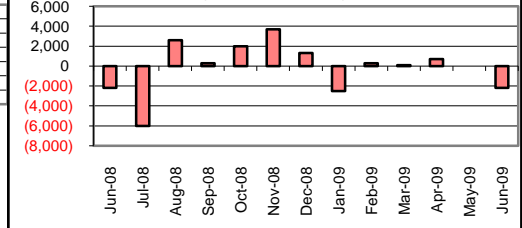
**Annual Growth Rate for Total NonAgricultural Employment**

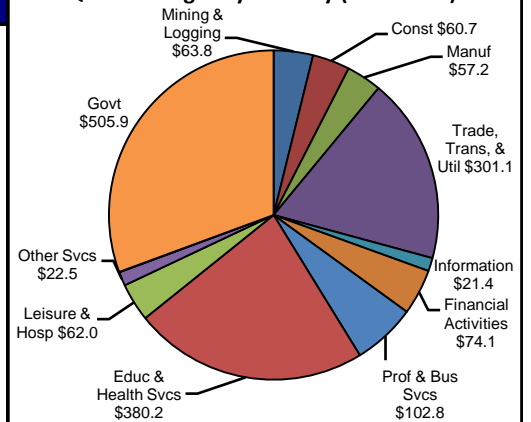

**Comments for June 2009**

Total Nonagricultural Employment in the McAllen-Edinburg-Mission MSA fell by 2,200 jobs over the month, while 300 jobs were gained since June 2008. The employment decline was primarily in Local Government and State Government and due to seasonal decreases within the educational institutions for the summer break. Local Government posted an over-the-month loss of 1,500 jobs. This industry reflected a gain of 1,700 jobs since June 2008 and registered a 4.0 percent annual growth rate. State Government registered a drop of 200 jobs for the month of June. Federal Government acquired 100 jobs over the month and registered a 13.3 percent annual growth rate, its largest growth rate since June 2000. Professional Business Services increased by 100 jobs, the first over-the-month increase since October 2008.
